- Violent, indecent, disorderly, intimidating, threatening or abusive behaviour or language
- Fighting / physical or verbal assault
- Computer misuse including, but not limited to, accessing pornographic websites on the internet
- Breach of any provision of any centre's rules or regulations

If any member of Inspired Sisters including staff is in breach of this code of behaviour, Inspired Sisters will then apply the appropriate disciplinary Procedure.
